

## Prohibited Firearms in the State of Illinois

In accordance with ILCS 5/24-3, Section A, Subsection (h), C.O.P.S, Inc. may not sell, or deliver to an unlicensed individual any **handgun** having a barrel, slide, frame or receiver which is a **die casting of zinc alloy or other non-homogeneous metal** that melts or deforms at a temperature of less than 800 degrees Fahrenheit.

This restriction currently covers many popular and inexpensive handguns including, but not limited to, the following:

<b>Bryco</b>	All models, all calibers
<b>Butler</b>	All derringers
<b>Chiappa</b>	1873-22, 1911-22
<b>Clerke</b>	All revolvers
<b>Cobra</b>	Standard, big bore, long bore derringers; all models, all calibers Denali Automatic; all models, all calibers CA semiauto; all models, all calibers FS semiauto; all models, all calibers
<b>Colt</b>	Frontier Scout with serial number suffix “K”, or “P”, Lord Derringer, Lady Derringer
<b>EAA</b>	Windicator .38 revolvers; all models
<b>ERMA</b>	EP-22, LA-22, ET-22
<b>FIE</b>	GT25, Cowboy .22LR, E15, Titan 25, Titan Tiger, Arminius HW5, HW38, all derringers
<b>GSG</b>	Firefly; GSG-1911 (All .22LR models), GSG 5-P, GSG 5-PK, GSG 522P, GSG 522PK
<b>Heritage</b>	Rough Rider .22 “Alloy” frame models
<b>Hi-Point</b>	All models, all calibers of their <i>handguns</i>
<b>Jennings</b>	All models, all calibers
<b>Jimenez</b>	All models, all calibers
<b>Lorcin</b>	All models, all calibers
<b>Phoenix Arms</b>	HP22/HP25
<b>Raven Arms</b>	P25, MP25
<b>Reck</b>	All models (includes private labels: LA Fury, Chicago Cub, P8)
<b>Rohm/RG</b>	All revolvers except .357 mag, .41 mag, .44 mag, .45 Colt, all automatic pistols
<b>SIG Sauer</b>	Mosquito .22LR
<b>Smith &amp; Wesson</b>	SW 380 Sigma, SW9M Sigma

<b>Stallard Arms</b>	All models
<b>Sterling</b>	300, 302
<b>Sundance Arms</b>	All models
<b>Walther</b>	Walther P22, PPK/S 22, PPQ .22 Uzi .22 pistol Heckler and Koch 416 .22 pistol Colt/Umarex 1911 .22

These restrictions apply to transfers as well as to store sales. **Call if you have questions.**

**Please note:** These restrictions apply only to licensed dealers during sales and transfers and do not apply to private individuals transferring existing firearms within the state. If you already own a firearm covered by this law, you may continue to own, shoot, and sell it privately to another non-licensed individual.
